Dates: The series is planned to run from June 20 to September 11, 2021. Each Residency runs for one week from Monday through the following Sunday.

Residency hours: Artists are expected to use the opportunity to put at least 25 hours into their project and associated “pop-up.” Artists are responsible for scheduling their own hours, and should be in regular touch with the FAA to ensure the best possible media coverage of their residency.

Confirmation of residencies and communications: Artists are expected to confirm their residency the week prior. Please check your email and phone messages regularly especially in the week prior to your residency and at the end of the summer when the Artist-in-Residence exhibition is being planned.

Promotion: Please do tweet, Facebook, Instagram and use social media to promote your residency. We encourage artists to also promote other artists’ residencies during the summer so everyone gets the widest possible exposure.

Advertising: Advertising specifically about the residencies will appear in the *Daily Gleaner* and CBC where possible and FAA’s *artsNEWS*, courtesy FAA. The city also does general advertisement for the residencies in their publications.

End of Summer Exhibition: The FAA will try to celebrate the work of the Artists in Residence with a fall exhibition at the Charlotte Street Arts Centre. Please think during your residency about what you would like to include in this exhibition.
