

Notice to Visual, Performance, Media and Literary Artists and Artisans:

Artists in Residence Summer Series 2010 Soldiers' Barracks Casemates A Project of the Fredericton Arts Alliance

The Fredericton Arts Alliance is organizing another season of *Artists-in-Residence*, a series of short-term artist residencies for one-week duration. (Each residency starts on a Saturday and finishes the following Friday). Participating artists will each be paid an honorarium of \$400 per week and may sell their work. They will be required to be on location for a set schedule of 23.5 hours each week, in partnership with another artist for a total of 47 hours. The residencies are located in one of the exhibition rooms of the York Sunbury Museum. The residencies will be part of the cultural tourism programming, and will be promoted by the City's tourism division and the FAA. The Residencies are intended to run from May 29th- Sept 24th. (The Program's schedule may be shortened on either end. Therefore, we will scheduling on a month-to-month basis until all our funding is confirmed). Artists must be living in the Fredericton region. (Note: You are not in the Fredericton Region if you have to make a long distance call when calling Fredericton). New artists applying will have first preference. The city generally hosts an exhibition at the end of the summer and it is expected that work completed during the residency will be on display. This year emerging artists will be invited to participate in a public art project with RBC's Emerging Artist's program following the exhibition.

If you are interested in participating in a residency, please prepare:

Visual Arts and Craft:

- Completed application form (below).
- 10 images of your recent work. (Only electronic media will be accepted via email or images on CD's or DVD's)
- Image descriptions including dimensions and materials used. (Please include the descriptions on a sheet of paper, separate from the images.)
- Résumé or curriculum vitae.
- Three References: (One should be work-related, two should be character references)

Performing Arts:

- Completed application form (below).
- A sample of work (No more than 10 mins (CD or DVD)
- Description of work including location, writer, director, etc).
- Résumé or curriculum vitae.
- Three references. (At least one should be work-related. At least one should be a character reference).

Literature:

- Completed application form (below).
- 10 pages of your recent work. (Only electronic media will be accepted via email or on CD's or DVD's)
- Work descriptions including title, year and name of publisher. (Please type the descriptions on a sheet of paper, separate from work sample.)
- Résumé or curriculum vitae.
- Three References: (One should be work-related, two should be character references)

* Any artists who participated in 2002-09 generally need submit no documentation or references, but **must** fill out the application form. However, we may require a small selection of work samples for the jury if they are unfamiliar with your work. You will be contacted individually, if work samples are required.

A selection committee comprised of respected artists and crafts people will review the applications. Though your work may be juried as acceptable you may be refused if we cannot schedule you in.

Established Artists: Artists who have been practising professionally in their discipline or in the arts for a sustained period of time (more than 5 years), and are able to demonstrate a regional, national, or international recognized contribution to their discipline or to the arts in general.

Emerging Artists: Artists who are striving to achieve a professional level in their discipline, and who can: demonstrate their commitment to the development of specialized skills or knowledge in their discipline; demonstrate their commitment to the achievement of a professional level in their discipline through training, mentorship, or peer recognition; and who are producing a growing repertoire or body of work. Emerging Artists include student artists and artists who have worked in their field 5 years or less.

Participating artists and the Fredericton Arts Alliance will enter into a formal contract. Details are available on request.
